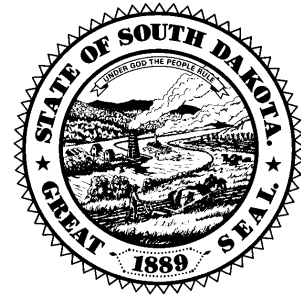

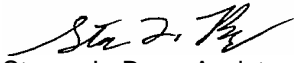

1. **Contract Term:** This notice establishes contract(s) resulting from IFB # 25458 for a period of one (1) year, from December 1, 2010 through November 30, 2011 inclusive. The Solicitation and the vendor's response, along with the South Dakota Vendor's Manual are made part of the vendor's contract by this reference.
2. **Extension:** The State may, at its own discretion, extend a contract for an additional two (2) months past the original contract expiration date. Further extensions may be for a period of one year. Notice shall be given by the State to the vendor at least 60 days prior to the termination of the contract, and the vendor shall agree to such extension within 30 days thereafter, before such extension period shall become effective.
3. **Pricing:** All prices quoted in the referenced proposal are firm for the term of this contract. Price decreases are acceptable on invoice(s) presented for payment. If the open market price of a specific contract item is under the vendor's price, the State reserves the right to purchase the lower priced product.
4. **Delivery:** The contractor shall furnish and deliver all of the awarded items of supplies, equipment, and commodities enumerated in the schedules and specifications, at the price and according to the terms and conditions, and of the kind, quality, and amounts and at the times specified in the schedules and specifications. The supplies, equipment and commodities shall be delivered to the Director of the Office of Procurement Management or to such State Department or State agency as he shall direct and such delivery shall be made without cost to the State.
5. In the event of the inability or failure of the contractor to furnish and deliver any item or items enumerated in the schedules and specifications at the time and in accordance with the terms and conditions therein provided, the Director of the Office of Procurement Management may contract for or purchase such supplies, equipment, and commodities in the open market and the contractor shall make good the excess over the price named in the schedule and specifications and the cost of such supplies, equipment, and commodities in the open market provided however, that the foregoing provisions shall not apply where other penalties for any default in the performance of the conditions of this contract are provided for in the schedules and specifications.
6. All orders shall be shipped F.O.B. destination. Deliveries shall be made at such time, place and in such quantities as shown on the Purchase Order. All items in common usage are to be shipped within 30 days from the date of purchase order. An additional 10 days will be allowed for back-ordered items when notification is given, in writing, to the ordering agency that the items are not available for immediate delivery.
7. All delivery tickets, invoices and statements shall show the purchase order number, brand or trade name and State Item Number when applicable as shown in this contract. Invoices must be submitted in duplicate to the State Agency ordering the merchandise. **DO NOT SUBMIT STATEMENTS OR INVOICES TO THE OFFICE OF PROCUREMENT MANAGEMENT AS IT ONLY DELAYS PAYMENT.**

8. **Surety:** This contract(s) shall be in full force and effect upon the execution and delivery thereof and the furnishing and delivery by the Contractor, to the Office of Procurement Management, of a good and sufficient Surety Bond in the sum required by the above-referenced solicitation, to be approved by the Office of Procurement Management.
9. STATE AGENCIES MUST INCLUDE ITEM NUMBERS AND A BRIEF DESCRIPTION WHEN ORDERING FROM THIS CONTRACT.
10. **Unless otherwise indicated, payment for items on the contract(s) may be made with the South Dakota Purchasing Card (Citibank Master Card). State agencies may use the Purchasing Card when making purchases of \$1000.00 or less per transaction.**

## 2011 Legislative Printing (Eighty-Sixth Session)

The Legislature is the author and publisher of the journals, the bills and resolutions introduced in the Legislature and the Session Laws. This material is in public domain and the successful bidders for the printing thereof may not claim or attempt to claim copyright for any part of such material.

Legislative organization and planning subjects these specifications to such revision as is deemed advisable by the Legislature, provided such changes do not entail additional labor and material cost.

### 1. PRINTING AND BINDING THE DAILY JOURNALS OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH LEGISLATIVE SESSION.

PAPER STOCK: #4 Offset, 50# Sub., white, regular, with a minimum of 30% Post Consumer Content. Second color to be used for correction portion.

QUALITY OF PRINTING: Medium.

COMPOSITION: The Director of the Legislative Research Council will furnish a digital copy of the House and Senate Journal following each day's legislative session. The digital copy will be provided electronically to the printer. The printer shall photo reduce the copy to 6 inch by 9 inch finished printed size, similar to the journals of the 84th Legislative Session. The digital copy will be made available after each day's session as soon as possible. The Journals shall be printed in off-set quality using liquid ink.

BINDING: 100 Journals shall be folded, gathered, punched with two 1/4 inch dia. round holes 4-1/4 inch C. to C. and side stitched with two wire staples. 40 journals shall be folded, gathered & slip sheeted with a different color by day, untrimmed, no drilling.

40 journals shall be Edition Bound in black Studite quality 18, or equal, cloth cases. The spine shall be stamped in gold leaf with date & name like the journal of the 85<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session.

NUMBER OF COPIES: The number of daily journals to be printed shall be 140 copies, to be distributed as designated by the Legislature after it is in session. The daily journals, including corrections made thereto, shall also be used as the permanent journals. (SDCL 2-7-10 and 2-7-11).

**DELIVERY:** **ALL COPIES SHALL BE DELIVERED TO THE LEGISLATURE IN CARE OF THE OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COUNCIL** or to a location designated by him, **(at least two hours before the convening of the Legislature on the following legislative day)**. Journals for the last legislative day shall be delivered within 24 hours after copy has been submitted to the vendor, not including Saturday, Sunday or legal holidays.

**PENALTIES:** If the vendor fails to deliver as specified above a penalty of \$100.00 per hour for each hour's delay shall be deducted from any sums due to him on the contract or recovered from him by a civil action on behalf of the State if a deduction from the contract cannot be made. The Director of the Legislative Research Council may waive the penalty provisions of this section when failure to deliver the daily journals as required is due to circumstances which the Director considers to be sufficiently extenuating (SDCL 2-7-8).

## **2. PRINTING AND BINDING THE INDEX TO THE EIGHTY-SIXTH LEGISLATIVE SESSION.**

**PAPER STOCK:** #1 Offset, 50# Sub., white, regular finish, with a minimum of 30% Post Consumer Content.

**QUALITY OF PRINTING:** Excellent.

**COMPOSITION:** Camera-ready copy shall be provided on 8-1/2 inch by 11 inch paper. The final product shall be reduced to 6 inch by 9 inch finished copy unless otherwise noted. The index shall be printed similar to the manner in which it was done in the 2010, Eighty-Fifth Session. The bid shall include the price per page for printing the separate index book.

This shall entail the bid for printing additional information regarding the House and Senate permanent journal as prescribed by the Legislature and an index. It is estimated that this would entail from 300 to 500 pages of finished copy including an index prepared under the supervision and direction of the Director of the Legislative Research Council. The index will be prepared "camera-ready" for the printer in 8-1/2 inch by 11 inch copy. This bid shall include prices for finished copy 6 inch by 9 inch.

BINDING OPTION 1: The index shall be Edition Bound in black Studite quality 18, or equal, cloth cases. The spine and front panel shall be stamped in gold leaf with the date and name like the index of the Seventy-Fifth Session.

BINDING OPTION 2: The index shall be soft cover, perfect bound, with 10 pt. coated one side cover, printed 2 color, not stamped, same copy as hard cover.

NUMBER OF COPIES: The number to be printed shall be at least 100 copies. Price per copy beyond 100 shall be provided.

DELIVERY: Index for the Eighty-Sixth Session shall be furnished camera-ready to the vendor not later than 60 days after adjournment, sine die, of the Legislature.

All Indexes shall be delivered to the Legislative Research Council within 90 calendar days after adjournment, sine die, of the Legislature.

PENALTIES: See paragraph #25.

### **3. FOR PRINTING AND BINDING OF BILLS AND, RESOLUTIONS AS REQUESTED FOR THE DAILY USE OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH LEGISLATIVE SESSION.**

PAPER STOCK: #4 Offset, 50# Sub., regular finish, with a minimum of 30% Post Consumer Content.

COLORS: Senate Bill - Canary House Bill - Blue  
Senate Joint Resolution - Canary House Joint Resolution - Blue  
Senate Resolution of Disapproval - Canary House Resolution of Disapproval - Blue

MILL: Fraser BRAND NAME: Torchglow

PRE-FILING: Pre-filing of bills and resolutions thirty days prior to the convening of the legislative sessions is governed by statute. A digital copy will be furnished to the printer by the Legislative Research Council and the printer shall print and deliver to the Legislative Research Council pre-session filed bills and joint resolutions as copy is received prior to convening of the Legislature. Pre-filed bills and joint resolutions must be delivered within forty-eight (48) hours after receipt of copy, not including Saturday, Sunday of legal holidays, unless waived by the Director of the Legislative Research Council.

Specifications for bills and resolutions including pickups and delivery not found in this section are the same as in Item #1.

DURING SESSION: COPY: Copy will be furnished in digital format in a manner which will also advise the printer of its availability for printing. The Chief of Enrolling and Engrossing will be responsible for advising the contract printer when the copy is ready. The camera-ready copy shall be picked up and signed for by the contract printer, or by someone in his employ, from the Legislative Research office in the State Capitol, Pierre, S.D. This will be daily or more often as desired by the Director of the Legislative Research Council.

PRINTING: Two sides, black ink.

BINDING AND SIZE: All bills, joint resolutions, and resolutions of disapproval are to be gathered, folded, saddle stitched, punched on 11 inch side for standard 3 ring binder and trimmed to 8-1/2 by 11 inch size in a neat and workmanlike manner, 11 inch way is the binding edge. The bills shall be printed in off-set printer quality using liquid ink.

NUMBER OF COPIES: 135 copies each of bills, joint resolutions and resolutions of disapproval shall be printed. A bid for additional quantities is also requested.

DELIVERY: All bills and joint resolutions are to be physically delivered completed to the Director of the Legislative Research Council in care of the Legislative Documents Room in the State Capitol within 38 hours from the time the contract printer is notified the camera-ready copy is ready to be picked up as specified under "COPY" above.

All printer's copies of bills must be picked up at the Capitol not later than 4:00 pm. CST on the day of introduction. All printed copies of these bills must be delivered not later than 6:00 a.m. CST of the second day following pick up. (This timetable is designed to allow thirty-eight hours for the contract printer. Bills picked up on Fridays are to be delivered by 6:00 a.m. the following Monday.)

PENALTIES: Failure to make delivery of bills, joint resolutions and resolutions of disapproval as specified herein shall make the vendor liable for a forfeiture of 1/2 the printing cost per bill or joint resolution for each day or portion thereof so delayed. Upon the written advice, the Director of the Legislative Research Council shall certify to the Bureau of Administration the amount of such penalty and deduct the same from the total due the vendor.

**4. PRINTING AND BINDING THE GENERAL SESSION LAWS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH LEGISLATIVE SESSION.**

PAPER STOCK: #1 Offset, White, 50# regular finish, with a minimum of 30% Post Consumer Content.

QUALITY OF PRINTING: Excellent

COMPOSITION: Camera-ready copy shall be prepared by the Legislative Research Council and Code Counsel and forwarded to the vendor (printer) within 45 calendar days from the date the last bill is signed or vetoed. The vendor will be notified, within seven (7) days from the date the last bill is signed or vetoed, of the estimated number of pages by the Code Counsel.

NUMBER OF COPIES: 425 Optional: Provide price for 400 copies.

DELIVERY: The vendor, within thirty (30) days from the receipt of the camera-ready copy, shall deliver to the Bureau of Administration one-half of the number of books provided for in this contract, and the remainder within twenty (20) days thereafter.

PENALTIES: Failure to make delivery as specified herein shall subject the vendor to a penalty of 1% of the contract for each and every calendar day of delay and in making final settlement with the vendor, the Director of Procurement Management shall certify the amount of such penalty and deduct it from the total amount due the vendor.

BINDING OPTION 1: All books in this item will be permanently case bound in brown Law Buckram of the same weight and quality as that used in binding of the 1995 Session Laws. They shall be sewed and bound, excellent quality workmanship. All books shall have extra quality super or heavy muslin on the backs to firmly hold the covers. They shall be labeled with embossed labels on the spine and lettered in gold leaf as follows: Session Laws of South Dakota 2011.

BINDING OPTION 2: Books will be perfect bound using 10 pt. coated one side cover, printed 2 colors to match above brown. Printed, not stamped, with same copy as above. (Same as the 2010 Session Laws.)
