SD/IA/MN Border Tax Seminar Offered in Sioux Falls

(PIERRE, SD) - A seminar being held in Sioux Falls this month will offer helpful state tax information to area business owners who conduct business in South Dakota, Iowa and Minnesota.

The South Dakota Department of Revenue and Regulation, the Iowa Department of Revenue, and the Minnesota Department of Revenue will be presenting a Border Sales Tax Seminar scheduled for Wednesday, Oct. 28 in conjunction with the Sioux Falls Products Show. The seminar will be held in Seminar Room #6 at the Sioux Falls Convention Center, 1201 N West Avenue.

The Sales and Use Tax Seminar is set from 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. Topics to be covered at the seminar include how and when to apply for a sales tax license; when to apply South Dakota tax vs. Iowa or Minnesota tax; exemptions from sales and use taxes; agricultural products and production; local taxes; use tax; and filing returns.
